RESOLUTION NO: 13-TM-15**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe is the parent council for the four (4) constituent Bands of Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

WHEREAS, in order to properly abide by the Ordinance and Laws of the Te-Moak Tribe, Liquor License is requested for a Hispanic Dance (Lori/Maria Ortega); and

WHEREAS, in accordance to the Te-Moak Liquor Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-03, section 1, paragraph (d). No such License shall be issued without the approval of the local governing body of the Colony of Reservation of the Te-Moak Bands of Western Shoshone, Nevada, upon the territory of which the proposed alcoholic beverage business is seeking to be licensed: and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Te-Moak Council is authorizing a Liquor License be issued to Lori/Maria Ortega for the Hispanic Dance taking place on June 1, 2013 at the Elko Colony Gymnasium, 2250 Indian View Heights.

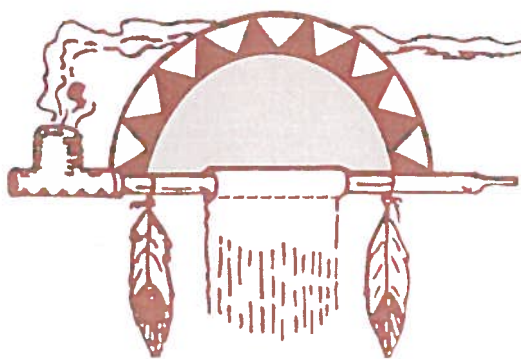

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE ELKO BAND COUNCIL

Resolution No. 2013-EBC-10

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ELKO BAND COUNCIL, that

WHEREAS, this organization is an Indian Organization known as the Elko Band Council as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of June 1934, as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and to be responsible for the promotion of the social and economic welfare of its tribal members: and

WHEREAS, in order to properly abide by the Ordinance and Laws of the Te-Moak Tribe, a Liquor License is requested for a Hispanic Dance (Lori/Maria Ortega); and

WHEREAS, this Liquor License in the Amount of \$1,500.00 dollars will be utilized on June 1, 2013 at the Elko Indian Colony Gymnasium, 2250 Indian View Heights: and

WHEREAS, in accordance to the Te-Moak Liquor Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-03, section 1, paragraph (d). No such License shall be issued without the approval of the local governing body of the Colony or Reservation of the Te-Moak Bands of Western Shoshone, Nevada, upon the territory of which the proposed alcoholic beverage business is seeking to be licensed: and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Elko Band Council hereby requests a Liquor License be issued to Lori/Maria Ortega for a Hispanic Dance by the Te-Moak Tribal Council, after the proper fee is paid along with an application for liquor license.

ROLL CALL: Gerald Temoke, Chairman, called the special closed meeting to order at approximately 4:00 P.M.

Suzanna brought to the Council's attention a liquor license request received from Araceli and Amador Ortega for the Mexican Dance to be held at the Colony Gym on June 1, 2013. She does not know if the Council would like to amend the agenda to include this request since this meeting is closed or if they would even like to consider the request since it may not be possible to obtain approval from Te-Moak Tribal Council because this event is prior to their meeting. Council asked why this request was not submitted sooner. Suzanna stated they wanted to wait to speak with the Council regarding rent before moving forward with the request. Elko Band received the liquor license request after Araceli and Amador met with the Council on May 15, 2013. Suzanna informed Jose, Gym Director, that the request may not be approved since it was not submitted sooner but would discuss it with the Council at tonight's meeting. She continued by saying in the past, the Te-Moak Administrator would sometimes do a phone poll to approve the liquor license requests and the prior Te-Moak Tribal Council was ok with it, they would then place it on their next meeting agenda for formal approval so it may be documented in the minutes. Suzanna said Te-Moak may not follow those same procedures as they have a new Administrator and Council. Elko Band Council discussed this issue. Council thought it would be worth requesting approval from Te-Moak for the liquor license. After discussion of this issue, Davis Gonzales motions to adopt Resolution 2013-EBC-10 and send to Te-Moak and is requesting this item be placed on the Elko Band Regular Meeting agenda on May 29, 2013 to discuss this issue in open forum as it is not a closed meeting issue. Paula Brady seconds the motion.

Dear Mrs. Conklin,

The Elko Band Council received a request for a liquor license on May 16, 2013. Araceli and Amador Ortega had met with the Council to discuss rental and usage of the Elko Indian Colony gym on May 15, 2013 and held off on submitting the liquor license until they spoke with the Council.

The Elko Band Council had a special meeting on May 22, 2013 at which time I informed them the liquor license request was received. I continued by notifying them the event the liquor license request is for is scheduled on June 1, 2013. I also informed the Council that in the past Te-Moak Administration had obtained approval for liquor license via phone poll and would then formally approve at their next regular scheduled meeting. The Elko Band Council discussed their options and decided to approve the Resolution # 2013-EBC-10 approving the liquor license and to submit the liquor license to Te-Moak Administration to try and obtain approval of the liquor license before June 1, 2013.

Elko Band Council understands the request may not be approved as it had been in the past, but would like to attempt approval from Te-Moak Council. Normally, liquor license requests are submitted a month prior to event to avoid this problem but in some circumstances we do receive late requests. I've attached a copy of the Elko Band resolution and draft minutes approving the liquor license. Please let me know if Te-Moak Administration and Te-Moak Council is willing to consider approval of this request. Thank you for your consideration on this matter.
